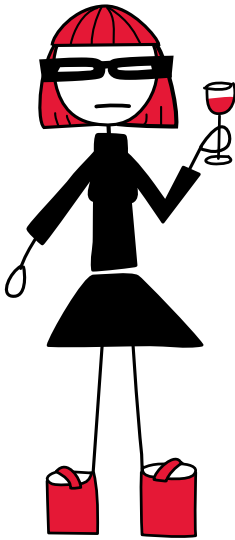


Middle Sister

What's in it?

38% Zinfandel, 34% Merlot,
21% Cabernet Sauvignon,
5% Syrah, 2% mixed red varieties.
100% California grapes with 42%
from the Lodi appellation.

How was it made?

Warm ferments (70-83°F) mixed
frequently for extraction of deep
color and dark fruit characters.

Wood?

15% barrel aged for a bit of complexity.

Smells like -

...ripe red and dark berry fruits like
plum, blueberry and blackberry.
Sassy dash of black and white
pepper with a dollop of crème de
cassis.

Tastes like -

...a huge mouthful of ripe summer
berries. The fruit goes on and on,
ending in a luxurious finish.
